Auscultation heart/ lungs: No abnormalities

Eyes: No abnormalities of the external or internal structures

Mild to moderate swelling on the lateral aspect of the fetlock LH. No other abnormalities on palpation/

manipulation

Shoeiing of both front feet

Movements:

No lameness at walk straight line

No lameness at trot straight line

No lameness at trot circle left hard surface

No lameness at trot circle right hard surface

No lameness at trot circle left soft surface

No lameness at trot circle right soft surface

Normal activity at canter

Flexion test LH: negatif





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Radiographic examination:

Foot LF: LM, Oxspring: Some very small synovial channels (within normale limits). No other radiographic abnormalities

Foot RF: LM, Oxspring: No radiographic abnormalities

Fetlock LF: LM: No radiographic abnormalities Fetlock RF: LM: No radiographic abnormalities

Fetlock LH: LM: Bony fragment at the lateral aspect of the fetlock (trauma in the past as a foal)

Fetlock RH: LM: No radiographic abnormalities

Hock L: LM, DL-PIMO, DM-PILO: Small osteochondral fragment at the intermediate ridge of the cochlea

tibiae

Hock R: LM, DL-PIMO, DM-PILO: No radiographic abnormalities

Stifle L: LM: No radiographic abnormalities Stifle R: LM: No radiographic abnormalities

The horse had a trauma at the fetlock in the past. The fragment LH is caused of that and has no clinical importance at this moment.
